-**Se lo he vendido** a Pepe. I sold it to Pepe.

-¿**Me ha enviado** tu hermana el paquete? Did your sister send me the package?

-Sí, ya **te lo ha enviado**. Yes, she already sent it to you.

-¿Quién **les ha enviado** ese paquete a ustedes? Who sent you that package?

-Mi tía Rosa **nos lo ha enviado**. Aunt Rosa sent it to us.

-¿A quién **le has prestado** la computadora? Who have you lent the computer to?

-A Meche **se la he prestado**. I've lent it to Meche.

-¿**Les ha prestado** Héctor el coche a ustedes? Has Hector lent the car to you?

-Sí, **nos lo ha prestado**. Yes, he's lent it to us.

-¿Quién **te ha prestado** el dinero? Who has lent you the money?

-**Me lo ha prestado** Juan. Juan has lent it to me.

-¿**Les has enseñado** las notas a tus padres? Did you show your parents your grades?

-Sí, ya **se las he enseñado**. Yes, I've already shown them.

-¿**Le ha enseñado** Marcia su casa a usted? Did Marcia show you her house?

-Sí, **me la ha enseñado**. Yes, she showed it to me.

-¿**Te ha enseñado** Marcia sus joyas? Did Marcia show you her jewellery?

-Sí, **me las ha enseñado**. Yes, she showed them to me.

-¿**Les ha enseñado** Roberto su coche a ustedes? Did Roberto show you his car?

-Sí, **nos lo ha enseñado**. Yes, he showed it to us.

-¿**Le ha vendido** Marcos su computadora a Rita? Did Marcos sell Rita his computer?

-No, **no se la ha vendido**. **Se la ha regalado**.

-Este coche **me lo ha vendido** un amigo. A friend sold me this car.

-¿Quién **te ha vendido** ese coche? Who sold you that car?

-Un amigo mío **me lo ha vendido**.

-¿Qué **te ha vendido** Petra? What did Petra sell you?

-**No me ha vendido** nada. She hasn't sold me anything.

-¿**Me ha traído** Rita las entradas? Did Rita bring me the tickets?

-Sí, **te las ha traído**. Yes, she brought them to you.

-Este libro **te lo ha traído** Anita. Anita brought you this book.

-¿Quién **me ha traído** ese libro?

-**Ha sido** Anita. It was Anita. Anita **te lo ha traído**. Anita brought it to you.

-Estas flores **se las ha traído** su novio a Susana. Susana's fiancé brought these flowers for her.

-¿Quién **le ha traído** esas flores a Susana? Who brought those flowers to Susan?

-**Se las ha traído** su novio. Her fiancé brought them to her.

-Ese paquete **se lo ha traído** un mensajero a don Rubén. A messenger brought that package for Mr Ruben.

-¿Quién **le ha traído** ese paquete a don Rubén?

-**Se lo ha traído** un mensajero. A messenger brought it to him.

-¿**Nos han invitado** a la fiesta? Did they invite us to the party?

-No, **no nos han invitado**. No, they didn't invite us.

-Héctor, ¿**has llamado** a tu padre? Hector, did you call your father?

-Sí, ya **le he llamado**. Yes, I've already called him.

-¿**Has vestido** ya a los niños? Have you already dressed the children?

-No, **no les he vestido** todavía. No, I haven't dressed them yet.

-¿**Has montado** alguna vez a caballo? Have you ever ridden a horse?

-Jamás **he montado** a caballo. I've never ridden a horse.

-¿**Se ha ido** María? Has Maria gone?

-Sí, pero vuelve pronto. Yes, but she'll be back soon.

-¿Cuándo **has quedado** con Graciela? When are you going to meet Graciela?

-El sábado **he quedado** con Graciela. I'm meeting Graciela on Saturday.

-**Hemos llegado** tarde, ¿verdad? We're late, right?

-Sí, **han llegado** tarde. Yes, you're late. El concierto ya **ha empezado**. The concert has already started.

-¿**Ha llegado** ya Gloria? Has Gloria already arrived?

-No, aún **no ha llegado**. No, she hasn't arrived yet.

-¿Todavía **no has pagado** el alquiler? Haven't you already paid the rent?

-No, ya **lo he pagado**. No, I've already paid it.

Lalo **ha vuelto** a suspender el examen. ≈ Lalo **ha suspendido** otra vez el examen. Lalo has failed to pass the exam again.

Marcelo **ha vuelto** a leer "Cien Años de Soledad". ≈ Marcelo **ha leído** "Cien Años de Soledad" de nuevo. Marcelo read "Cien Años de Soledad" again.

-¿**Has hablado** ya con Raquel? Have you already talked to Raquel?

-Sí, por fin **he conseguido** hablar con ella. Yes, I got to talk to her at last.

-¿**Has hablado** ya con Santiago? Have you already talked to Santiago?

-Sí, ya **he hablado** con él. Yes, I've already talked to him.

-Aún **no he acabado**. I'm not done yet. Espérenme un momento, por favor. Please, wait for me a moment.

-No te preocupes. No worries. Te esperaremos. We'll wait for you.

-¿**Han empezado** ya las clases? Have the classes already started?

-No, todavía **no han empezado**. Empiezan la próxima semana. They'll start next week.

-No, aún **no ha encontrado**. No, he hasn't found a job yet.

-¿**Ha comido** ya Paolo? Has Paolo already eaten?

-No, todavía **no ha comido**. No, he hasn't eaten yet.

-¿**Han comido** ya los niños? Have the children already eaten?

-Sí, ya **han comido**. Yes, they already ate. **Les he dado** de comer temprano. I fed them early.

-¿Qué **has comido** hoy? What did you eat today?

-Hoy **he comido** paella. Today I ate paella.

-¿Qué **han comido** ustedes?

-**Hemos comido** ceviche. We ate ceviche.

-¿**Te ha llamado** Sonia? Did Sonia call you?

-Sí, **me ha llamado** hace un momento. Yes, she called me a moment ago.
